



# MATERIALS FOR MORE SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION

## AIR PILLOWS



Used to fill empty spaces or for cushioning, most are recyclable, but must be left in specific recycling bins.

## ORGANIC FABRIC PACKAGING



Reusable bags made from organic fabrics like cotton, hemp and linen are generally degraded in 100 days, which is much better than 10,000 years for a plastic bag.

## CORNSTARCH PACKAGING



In the form of foam, this type of packaging can be used as a shock absorber, as a thermal insulator or as an anti-static safety pad for electronic devices.

You can make your compost or simply dissolve it in water, but the production of the corn starch packaging competes with the supply of corn for human and animal food, which can increase the price of this essential crop.
